



## **2009 Spring Vale Pinot Gris around \$28**

Pinot gris appears to be suffering an identity crisis in Australia at the moment, with producers either heading down the soft and sugary path, or attempting to make dry, riesling look-alikes.

Spring Vale's Dave Cush has charted an Alsatian course for this wine, and it really sails across the palate with an impressive texture and depth of flavour.

Around 1.7 g/litre of sugar makes it essentially bone dry. Bring it on.
